

Pam,

In April, Entech reached out to me regarding fire hydrant locations for their 2018 water main replacement project. I reviewed the layout with our officers, and we recommended the following:

- The existing FH in front of the previous Barrett school be eliminated, as the school was removed.
- Install a new FH at the southerly corner of the intersection of Route 390 and Thompson Way (yellow in the attached). This FH is essentially be a relocation of the Barrett school FH and will provide us with water for the houses along Thompson Way and further north along Route 390.
- Install a new FH along Hummingbird Lane & Route 390, between Mick Motors and the Lewcor building. That FH would provide us water to protect Mick Motors, TB Price and the Lewcor building.

I provided this information to Entech, and they are now requesting that the township provide a letter with these requests. See yellow. Could you request the BOS review these locations, and provide the requested letter. If anyone has any questions, please either contact me by email or phone.
